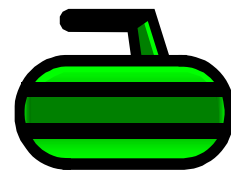

### Grant Funding for the Club

This spring/summer we applied for three grants and we were successful on all three proposals. First we applied to Community Places to fund the heat

reclaim project and the sprinkler system. The heat reclaim project involves installing a shell-in-tube heat exchanger in the plant room to recover heat from the ammonia that is used in the refrigeration cycle. Previously, a small amount of heat was recovered using a thermostore and the rest was rejected outside through the condenser. However, the thermostore reached end-of-life last February. The heat exchanger will replace the thermostore and will recover much more heat leaving little to be rejected outside. The recovered heat is circulated out to the ice shed via a glycol-water mixture to heat the air. An estimated savings of \$3000/yr in heating is expected.

The sprinkler system was required by code due to the addition of the new sportsplex. The fire safety code requires the sprinkler system when a building exceeds a certain size. Manitoba Community Places awarded us \$15,000 towards the two projects.

We also applied to the Canadian Curling Association for funding towards an advertising campaign. The campaign included printing and mailing 3700 pamphlets, placing a CCA ad in the Review, Leader, Clipper and Carillon, as well as advertising our registration dates in the Review and Clipper. The CCA awarded us \$2,000 towards this project.

We also applied to Manitoba Community Services Council for additional funding towards the roofing project and the heat reclaim project. We were awarded \$10,500 of which

\$9,000 will come from working 3 bingos at Club Regent.
